I am to inform you that the applications for the award of scholarship to the bright students among the children of the ex-servicemen for the academic year 2011-12 are being invited and notification to this effect is being sent for publicity through media. At the district level wide publicity will be made by the Zila Sainik Welfare Officers.

2. The Scheme is open for courses conducted by the following recognized institutions/ universities in Kerala through regular studies only.

- (a) Directorate of Public Instructions.
- (b) Directorate of Collegiate Education
- (c) Directorate of Medical Education
- (d) Directorate of Technical Education

- (e) Directorate of Vocational Higher Secondary Education
 (f) Directorate of Higher Secondary Education

3. Courses eligible for the scholarship and the rate of amount

(a)	Std X in High School (including KV)	=	Rs. 2,000.00
(b)	Final year in the Junior Technical School	=	Rs. 2,000.00
(c)	STD XI and XII (including KV)	=	Rs. 2,500.00
(d)	TTC, ITI VHSC	=	Rs. 2,500.00
(e)	Degree, BSc Nursing, HDC, JDC and B Ed	=	Rs. 3,000.00
(f)	B Ed course of Dakshina Bharat Hindi Prachara Sabha	=	Rs. 3,000.00

Diploma Courses

(a)	Diploma in Engineering	=	Rs. 3,000.00
(b)	Diploma courses conducted in Women Poly Technic	=	Rs. 3,000.00
(c)	Diploma courses in Arts	=	Rs. 3,000.00
(d)	Diploma courses in commercial subjects	=	Rs. 3,000.00
(e)	Certificate courses in Textiles Technology	=	Rs. 3,000.00
(f)	Certificate course in Pharmacies	=	Rs. 3,000.00

4. Eligibility for scholarship

- (a) At least 50 % of aggregate marks in the previous examination.
- (b) Annual income of the student or parents/ guardian of the student should not exceed Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees One lakh only) including basic pension of the Ex- servicemen per year.

Note:

- (a) A student in receipt of /applied for any other scholarship from the Government other than national loan scholarship shall not be eligible for Bright Students Scholarship.
- (b) Those students who are in receipt of scholarship stipend from the welfare fund of the Armed Forces, Department of Sainik Welfare are eligible for an amount, which is the difference if any between the scholarships admissible, under this scheme.

5. Application should be supported with the following documents

- (a) Filled up application signed by the student, guardian, counter signed by the Head of the Institution where the student is studying and Recommended by the Zila Sainik Welfare Officer.
- (b) A photocopy of Census Identity Card after verification of the discharge book/ SSLC Book for their relationship by the Zila Sainik Welfare Officer.
- (c) A Photocopy of the previous year mark list attested by a Gazetted Officer.
- (d) Income certificate in original obtained from the Village Officer not earlier than six month from the date of submitting the application. Purpose for issuing the certificate should be mentioned clearly.
- (e) Nominal roll of the application in 04 (four) sets.

- (e) One copy of checklist.

6. General Instructions and procedure

- (a) No application should be forwarded to this Directorate without proper scrutiny as per Para 4 & 5 above.
- (b) Students, who apply for scholarship, where previous year mark list cannot be produced, as the examinations were not conducted, may produce the mark list of the year proceeding to that. But a certificate to that effect from the Head of the Institution concerned should be submitted to support of the application. However, there will be no compromise on aggregate marks of 50%. Total marks obtained in the last year's final examination and percentage of marks should be clearly mentioned at column 19 of the application.
- (c) Students undergoing B. Ed courses should produce final year Degree marks list and Post Graduation marks list is not required.
- (d) In case of students of Degree courses, the year and course should be shown in column No.3 in Nominal roll such as I BA/II BA/B Sc instead of writing Degree I DC/II DC.
- (e) In case of students undergoing diploma courses under the Technical Education such application should be forwarded in one lot, for sanction scholarship to one student per course for the entire state having the best academic performance based on their record in the previous year.
- (f) If the marks in the qualifying examination are expressed in grade only, then equivalent percentage (100-point scale) duly certified by the concerned institutions must be furnished.
- (g) Application form can be sold at the cost of Rs. 2/-and the amount received may be deposited in Government Treasury. Photocopy of the relevant chalan may be forwarded to this Directorate along with the details of the application form held at Zila Sainik Welfare Office. The application form can also be downloaded from the department website www.sainikwelfarekerala.org, for which a Court Fee Stamp worth Rs.2/- shall be affixed in the application, as per Government direction vide letter No 6340/SW 1/07/GAD dated 11 Sep 2007.

- (h) All the connected documents should be kept inside the application form between pages No. 2 & 3 and tied up.
- (j) Completed applications are to reach to this Directorate by **15th November 2011**. *Only cases with genuine reasons for the delay will be considered thereafter.*
- (k) Zila Sainik Welfare Officers are requested to examine the applications thoroughly to avoid delay in sanction and unnecessary correspondences.
- (l) Allotment order for sanctioned amount on “TR-109” will be forwarded to Zila Sainik Welfare Officer concerned who will be responsible for drawing the money on TR-42 and disburse after getting a stamped receipt for the amount from the father/widowed mother or guardian and the fact intimated to the Head of the institutions, where the student is studying.
- (m) Please acknowledge the receipt.
