ORDER

In the G. O read as first paper above orders were issued to the effect that the requests for transfer of near relatives of soldiers to their native places should be considered sympathetically. Subsequently in G. O. second cited it was clarified that no distinction need be made between relatives of soldiers on active service and those working in base establishments in the matter of transfer of their near relative to their native places, it was laid in the G. O. third cited that the condition regarding the seniority need not be insisted on in the case of transferees so that they could be allowed to retain their original seniority in the new District. A doubt has arisen whether the first choice should be given to the near relative of jawans in preference to all other cases in the matter of transfer to their native places and whether more than one relative of a jawan should be given the benefit of this concession.

After having examined the matter in all its aspects, Government are pleased to issue the following orders:-

- Each petition of the near relative of jawan for the transfer of his/her native place will be disposed of on its merits.
- (2) Only one dependent of a Jawan will be given the benefit of this concession.
