CRAFTSMEN TRAINING SCHEME-ADMISSIONS—RESERVATION OF SEATS IN THE INDUSTRIAL
TRAINING INSTITUTES IN RESPECT OF EX-SERVICE PERSONNEL AND
THEIR RELATIONS—PROPOSAL SANCTIONED

ORDER

- In the G. O. read as first paper above, Government ordered that 10% of seats in various Industrial Training Institutions and centre be reserved for the children of Jawans who possess the minimum educational qualification and who are within the age limit prescribed.
- 2. Subsequently in the G. O. read as second paper sanction was accorded for the reservation of five seats in each Industrial Training Institute for Ex-servicemen provided they were otherwise qualified.
- 3. The Director of Training in the letter cited has reported that statistics reveal that the number of Ex-service personnel and children of Jawans applying for admission is negligible, where as the number of children of Ex-servicemen and the close relations of ex-service personnel and Jawans applying for admission is great, with a view to extending maximum benefits to Jawans and Ex-service personnel, who deserve special treatment in the matter of admission to Industrial Training Institutes. Government are pleased to order reservation of 15% of the total number of seats as shown below:—

Category I Category II Ex-service personnel

(i) Wives and children of Ex-service personnel

(ii) Wives and children of Jawans

Category III

Brothers and sisters of Ex-service Personal and Jawans 15% for all the categories put together preference being given to category I over category II and III and to category II over category III.

In deserving cases relaxation from upper age limit will be sanctioned by Government on pecific recommendation of the Director of Training.
