ORDER

In the G. O. read as first paper above, Government ordered that in the matter of allotment of N. G. Os. Quarters in the State, preference would be given to the N. G. Os. who are wives of Jawans, actually stationed in the border areas. As per the G. Os. read as second and third papers, the concession has been extended to the near relatives of the Jawans who are reported missing or dead, and to the wives (N. G. Os.) of officers and men of the Special Armed Police Stationed at Nagaland, respectively. When the national emergency was lifted, Government in the order read as fourth paper above, ordered that the preference shown to the wives of Jawans or relatives of Jawans reported missing or dead in the matter of allotment of N. G. Os. quarters, shall be discontinued.

2. Government have since reviewed the above orders and considering the various aspects of the question and the special nature of such cases they are pleased to order that in the matter of allotment of N. G. Os. Quarters the preference shown earlier to the wives (N. G. Os.) of Jawan who are reported missing or dead should be continued.

3. The G. O. read as fourth paper above is modified to this extent.
