ORDER

In G.O.(MS) No.70/76/TD. dated 10-6-1976 it was ordered that a physical efficiency test and a written test would be conducted for selection of candidates for the post of Excise Inspector as is being done for selection of candidates to the post of Sub-Inspector of Police. The Director General, Re-Settlements, Government of India has pointed out that the rigid standards prescribed by the State Government in the matter of physical efficiency are creating hurdles to the rehabilitation of Ex-servicemen in the post of Excise Inspector in spite of the relaxation in qualification and age. To help the Ex-Servicemen, the Board of Revenue has proposed that 25% concession may be given to them in the matter of tests in physical efficiency in view of the fact that the Ex-Servicemen would mostly be around the age of 45, when they are required to take these tests. Government have considered the question in detail in consultation with the Kerala Public Service Commission and are pleased to order that the following concessions will be allowed to the Ex-servicemen in the matter of physical efficiency tests for direct recruitment to the post of Excise Inspector.

| 1. Up to and including 35 years of age      | : No relaxation.                   |
| 2. 35 to 40 years of age including 40 years | : 15% relaxation in all standards. |
| 3. 41 to 45 years of age including 45 years | : 20% relaxation in all standards. |
| 4. 46 years of age and above                | : 25% relaxation in all standards. |

The above relaxations will be available only to Ex-Servicemen who are pensioners or who are entitled to pensionary benefits. For the purpose of calculation of age, the crucial date will be the first January of the year in which applications are invited.
