ORDER

At present there is no provision to give priority in employment to those disabled ex-servicemen with lesser percentage of disability and who are fit for civil employment. But the Gallantry Award Winners are being awarded grace marks by the Kerala Public Service Commission for selection made on the basis of competitive written tests. The Rajya Sainik Board in its meeting held on 5.12.1998 have resolved to extend the benefit of granting grace marks to the Exservicemen disabled in war or war like operations as in the case of gallantry award winners. The Director of Sainik Welfare in his letter read above has forwarded proposals accordingly.

2. Government have examined the proposal on detail. The Secretary, Kerala Public Service Commission in his letter read above has conveyed the approval of the Commission to extend the benefit of granting grace marks to the Exservicemen who are disabled in war or war like operations, and who come out

with a specific opinion of 'fit for civil employment', on par with Gallantry Award Winners.

In the circumstances Government are pleased to issue orders extending the benefit of grace marks to Ex-servicemen who are disabled in war or war like operations and who come out with a specific opinion of 'fit for civil employment', on par with the grace marks awarded to Gallantry Award winners, by the Public Service Commission.
