As per the Government Order read as first paper above, Government have approved a scheme of awarding scholarships to bright students among the children of Ex-servicemen whose annual income does not exceed Rs. 30,000.

- The Rajya Sainik Board at its meeting held on 14th November, 2000 resolved to recommend to Government that the present income limit may be enhanced to Rs. 50,000 per annum.
- 3. The Director of Sainik Welfare in his letter read as third paper above has requested Government to enhance the income limit for bright students' scholarship from Rs. 30,000 to Rs. 50,000 per annum.
- Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order that the income limit of the parents prescribed in Annexure-I of the G.O. Read above is amended as Rs. 50,000 instead of Rs. 30,000.
