In supersession of all existing orders in the subject, the Government are pleased to order as follows:—

- (i) Medical Degrees which have been approved by the All India Medical Council only should be approved.
- (ii) Other degree and Diplomas awarded by the Statutory Universities established by an Act of the Central or State Legislature or by the other institutions of higher learning recognised as Universities by the Central University Grants Commission, should be recognised.
- (iii) Certificates and Diplomas awarded by the Board of Secondary and intermediate Education duly set up and recognised by the Central Government or a State Government should be recognised.
- (iv) All technical and professional qualifications recognised by the Government of India should be recognised for purpose of appointment to various posts in Public Service in the State other than teaching posts.
  - (v) In case of doubt, the Government should be addressed.
